You may receive further individual communications regarding attendance as your child(ren) being in school and learning is essential – We will never apologise for having high expectations of attendance and challenging when this is not the case. A few reminders:

- Lateness can contribute to lost learning and result in unauthorised absences

- In instances where unauthorised attendance is high, this can and does result in fines being processed.
