Dear Parents/ Carers,

The busy Christmas half term is upon us! The excitement has already begun.

Uniform Shop:

Just a reminder that our uniform shop is available should you need any items. With the weather turning colder, we also have some lovely winter coats in stock. If you'd like one, simply send us a message on Seesaw - no questions asked.

Please note: trainers that are not completely black are not permitted. A small number of children have recently not followed uniform expectations regarding footwear, and we will be contacting families individually where necessary.

Medical

If there is any change in your child's health, it is your responsibility to inform school. For example, a change in asthma medication will require a new or updated asthma plan.

Appointments, unless urgent, should not be taken during school time. Routine dental checkups should always be booked during school holidays—call now and book ahead! (I've already booked mine for February!)

Air Tags

Air tags are not permitted on school trips. It has been brought to my attention both locally and nationally that parents/carers are using devices such as the Apple Air Tag to track children on school residentials/trips/visits/outings. Other devices can also include electronic watches that are essentially tracking devices with the capability of sending video footage from the device back to the person tracking i.e. parent. Such devices have the potential to post locations of children's whereabouts on social media. If any tracking devices are found on pupils, they will not be allowed on the trip and will be returned to school.

Attendance Phone Calls

We've noticed a decline in families contacting school to inform us of the reason for their child's absence. This results in office staff making numerous phone calls to chase information. Please always send a Seesaw message or phone the office to keep us informed. Failure to make contact may result in a home visit from myself and Mrs Crowther.

Parent Pay

A reminder to ensure that you have access to parent pay in readiness for any school based events. This needs to be in place before payments are required to avoid unnecessary delay.
