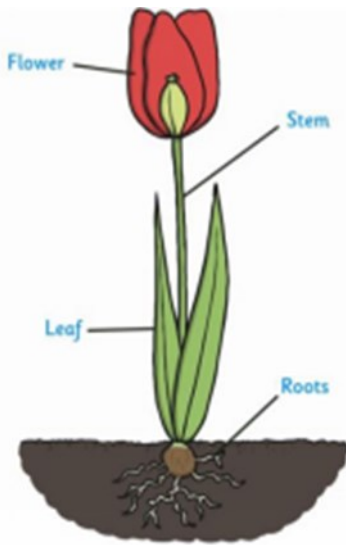

Plants

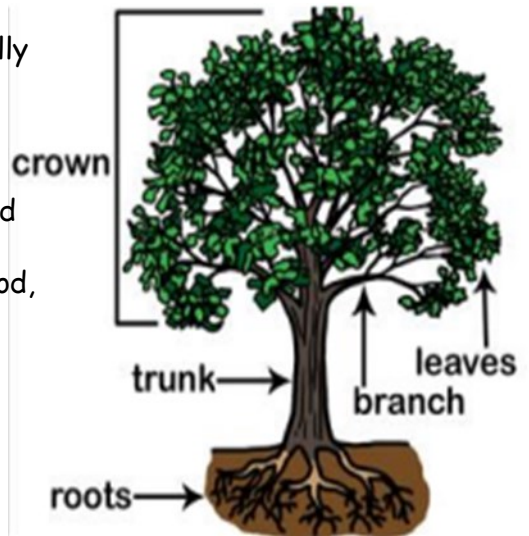
Key Learning



A plant is a living thing that usually grows from the ground.

Trees are plants.

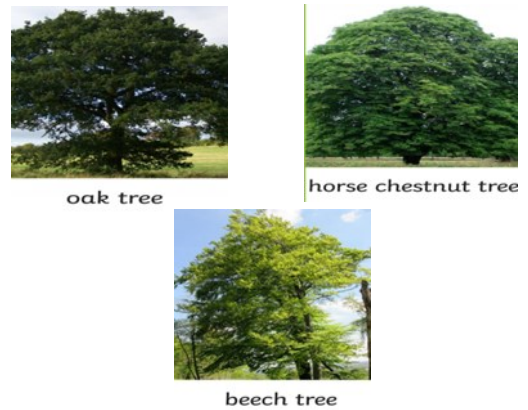
In order for a seed to survive and grow into a strong plant it needs, water, sunlight and nutrients (food, that it gets from the soil).

| seed | The small part of a plant that new plants grow from. |
| roots | Hold the plant in the ground and absorb water and nutrients from the soil. |
| stem | Takes water and nutrients to different parts of the plant. |
| flower | The part of a plant that blossoms. |
| leaves | Grows from the stem of the plant. |
| blossom | When a tree or bush grows flowers. |
| petals | The brightly coloured outside parts of the flower. |
| fruit | Holds the seeds from the plant and can be eaten (for example, apple, pear, orange). |
| bulb | Can come in different sizes, shapes, and types. Bulbs contain a complete tiny plant inside. |
| trunk | The stem of a tree which branches grow from. |
| branches | The part that sticks out from the trunk of a tree. |
| evergreen | A plant or tree that keeps its leaves all year. |
| deciduous | A tree that loses its leaves in Autumn and grows new ones in Spring. |

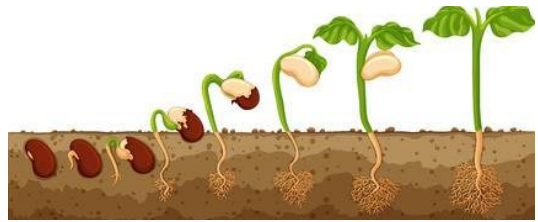

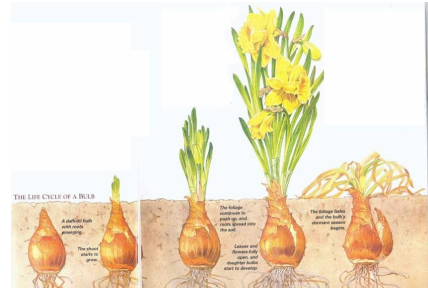
Plants have a life cycle.

Growth from a seed to a mature plant.

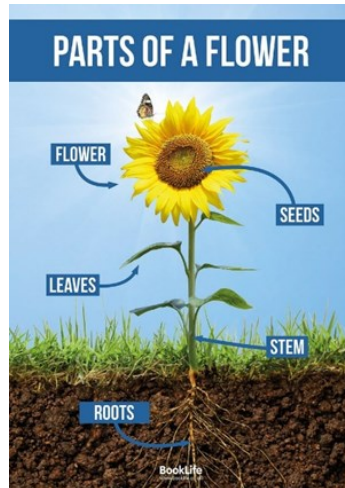


Seeds
