We can set personal goals by thinking about what we want to achieve.

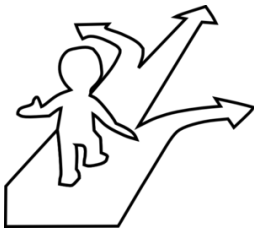
It is good to talk to someone when we feel worried.
